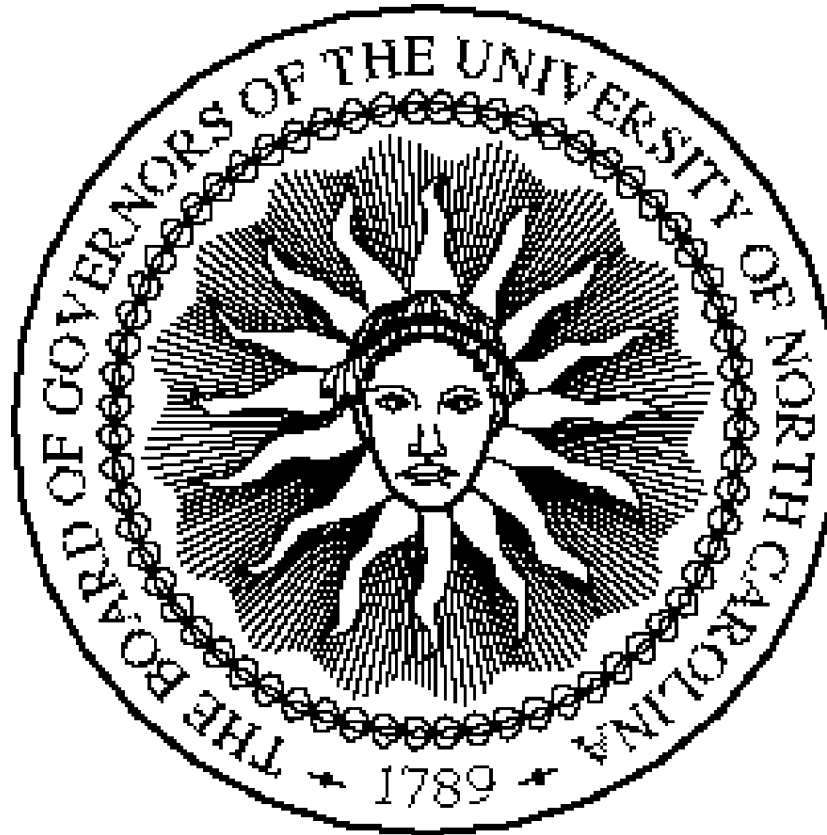


P/PB Summary Data on Research and Public Service Activities (1999-2000)

At Selected UNC Institutions

Highlights from P/PB Measures of Research and Public Service (1999–2000)

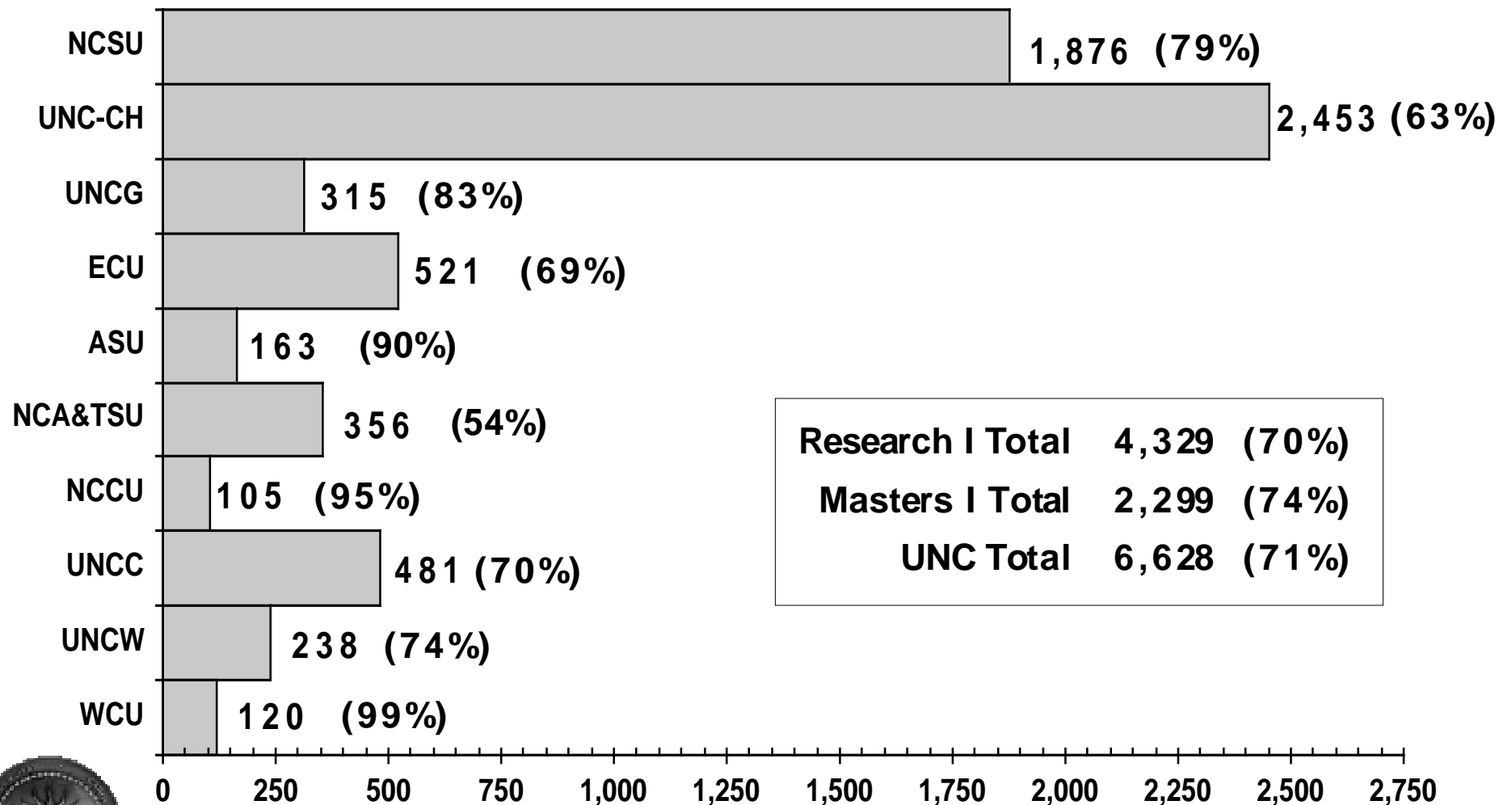
- In 1999-2000, UNC institutions submitted **over 6,600 proposals for sponsored awards**, 71% of which had either a North Carolina sponsor or an identified benefit for the state. (*up 3% and 9%, respectively*)
- The **total dollar value** of these requests exceeded \$2.0 billion and yielded over 600 million in awards. (*up 12% and 14%, respectively*)
- Over 60% of all proposals involved **collaboration** among principal investigators or institutions. (*up 20%*)
- Four out of five dollars awarded went to the **Research I institutions**. (*no change*)
- **Faculty systemwide produced** over 30,000 books, articles, public exhibits, and performances. (*up 2,000*)
- Short courses, seminars, workshops, and similar non-degree-credit continuing education activities served over **500,000 registrants** in 1999-00. (*up slightly*)
- Over **1.4 million North Carolinians** attended lectures, concerts, recitals, plays, art exhibits, and other cultural events offered by UNC institutions. Excluded from these counts are listeners to campus public radio stations, viewers of UNC TV programs, and spectators at intercollegiate athletic events. (*up 0.2 million*)
- Taken together, the public service centers and institutes at UNC institutions generated **0.89 dollars in non-state revenue for every dollar of state support** they received. (*no change*)

Notes on the P/PB Summary Data

- 1 Research measures are presented only for UNC institutions with state support for organized research. Excluded are ECSU, FSU, NCSA, UNCA, UNCP, and WSSU.
- 1 Sponsored research is funded by organizations external to the institution.
- 1 In 1999-2000, data on grants and contracts identified projects that have either a North Carolina benefit or sponsor, and projects that involve collaboration among institutions or principal investigators.
- 1 Because submitted multiyear proposals are counted only once, in the year they are submitted, while awards from such proposals are counted once per year, the number of awards can exceed the number of proposals.
- 1 Public service activities include continuing education courses, cultural events (excluding athletic), and the work of public service centers and institutes.
- 1 Registrants in non degree-credit activities and participants in cultural events are counted once for each activity or event in which they participate.

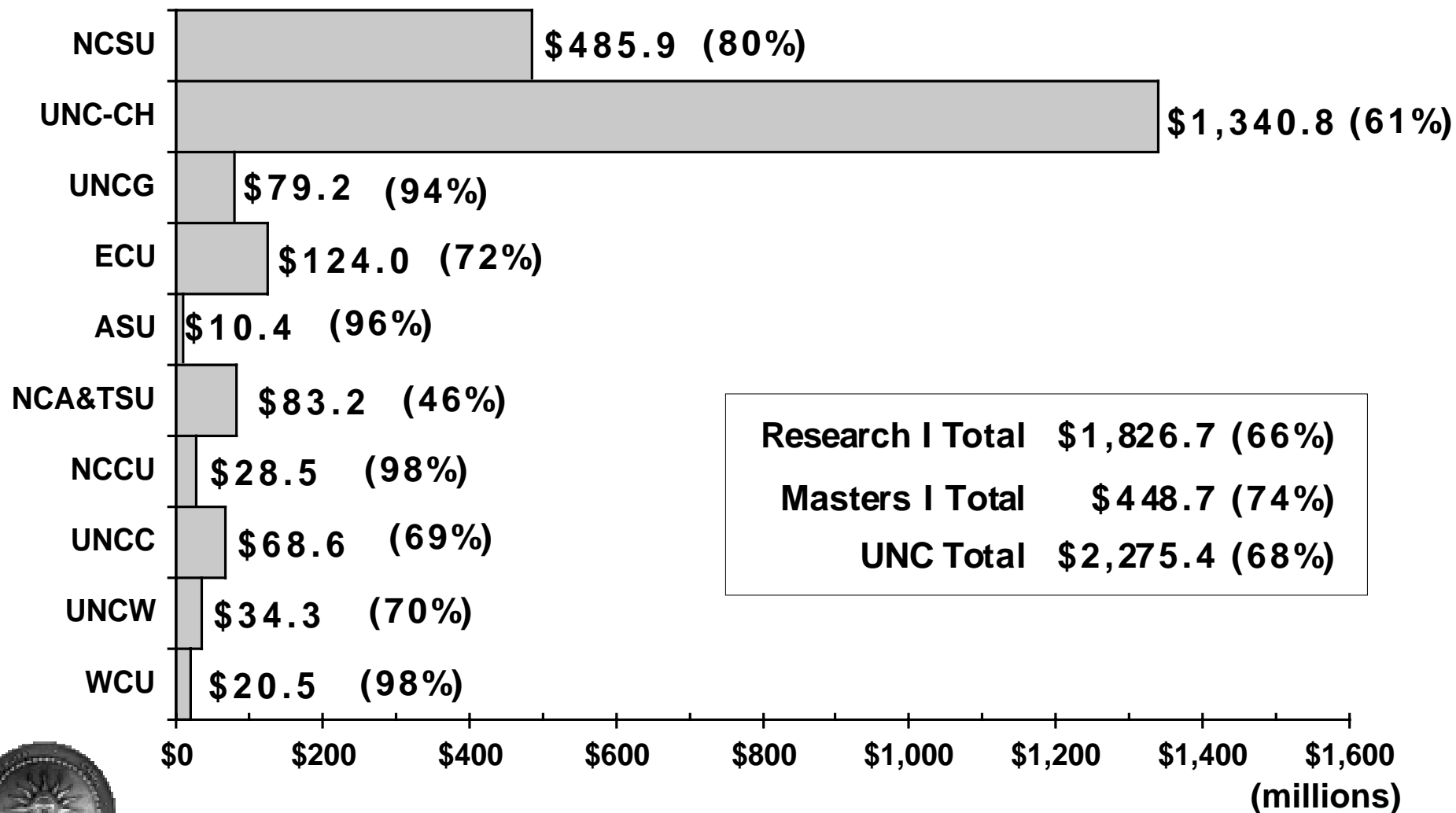


1999-2000 Number of Sponsored Research Proposals Submitted (and Percent with NC Benefit or NC Sponsor)



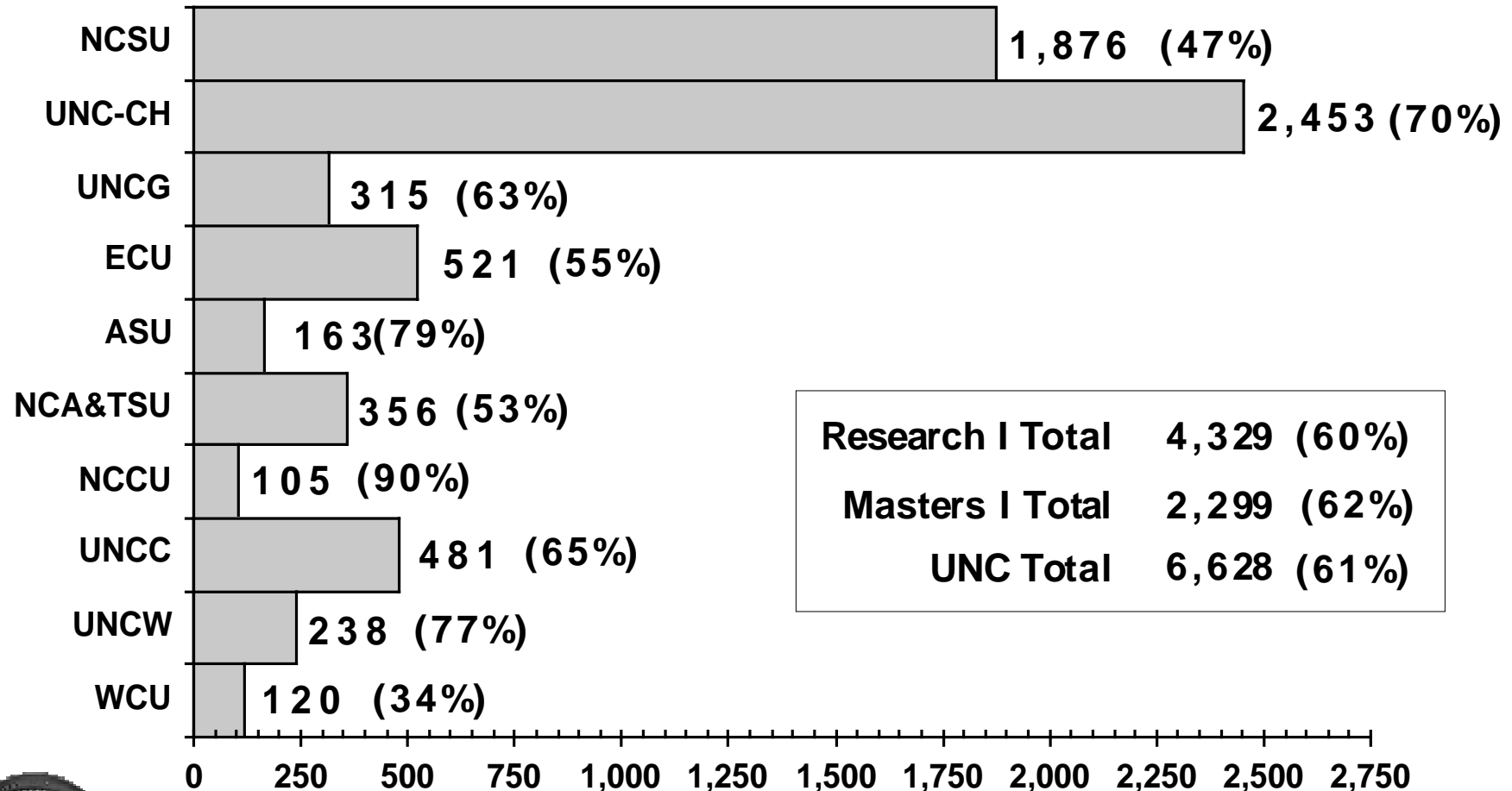

1999-2000 Dollar Value of Sponsored Research Proposals Submitted (and Percent with NC Benefit or NC Sponsor)



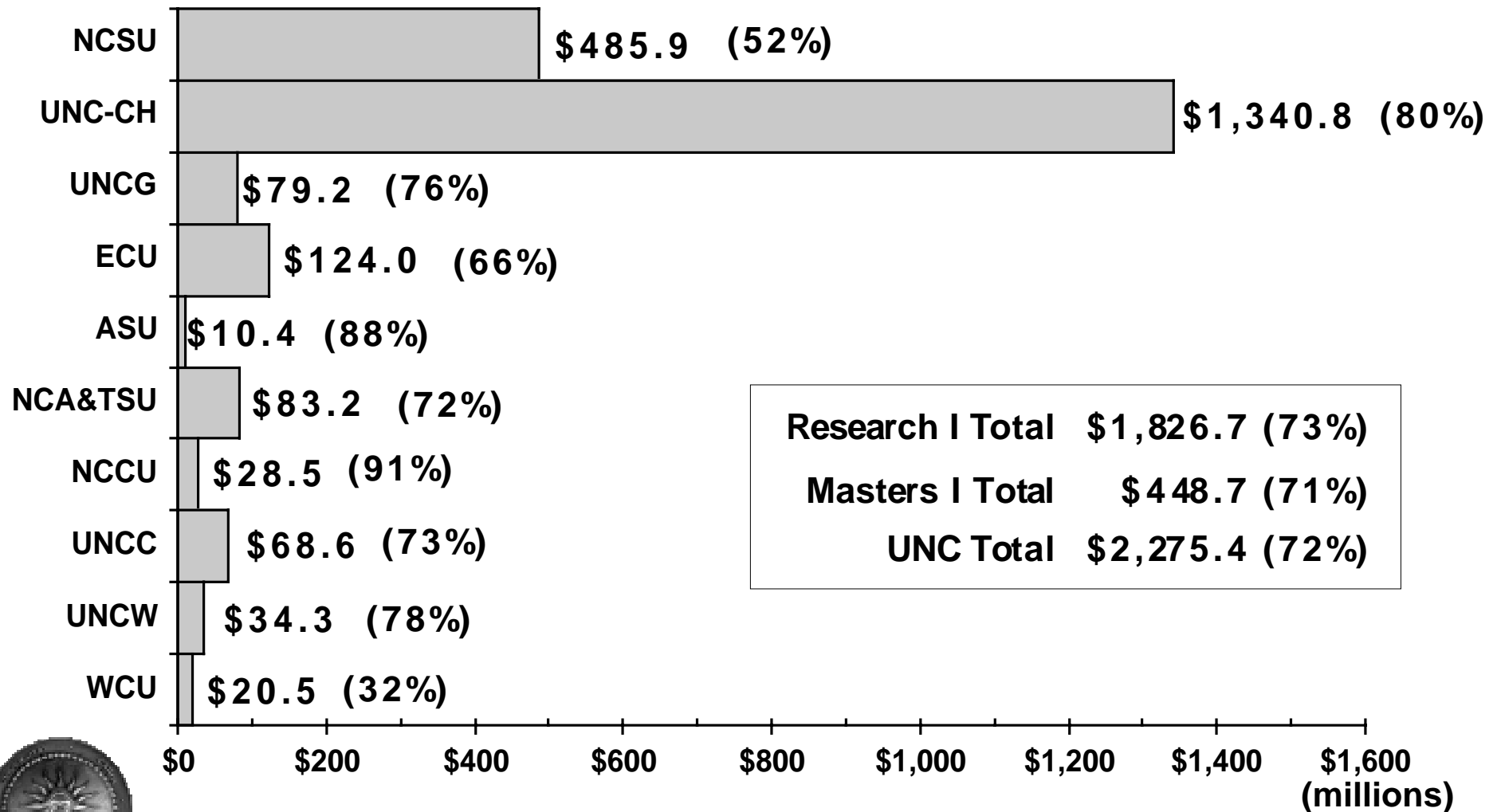

1999-2000 Number of Sponsored Research Proposals Submitted (and Percent Involving Collaboration)



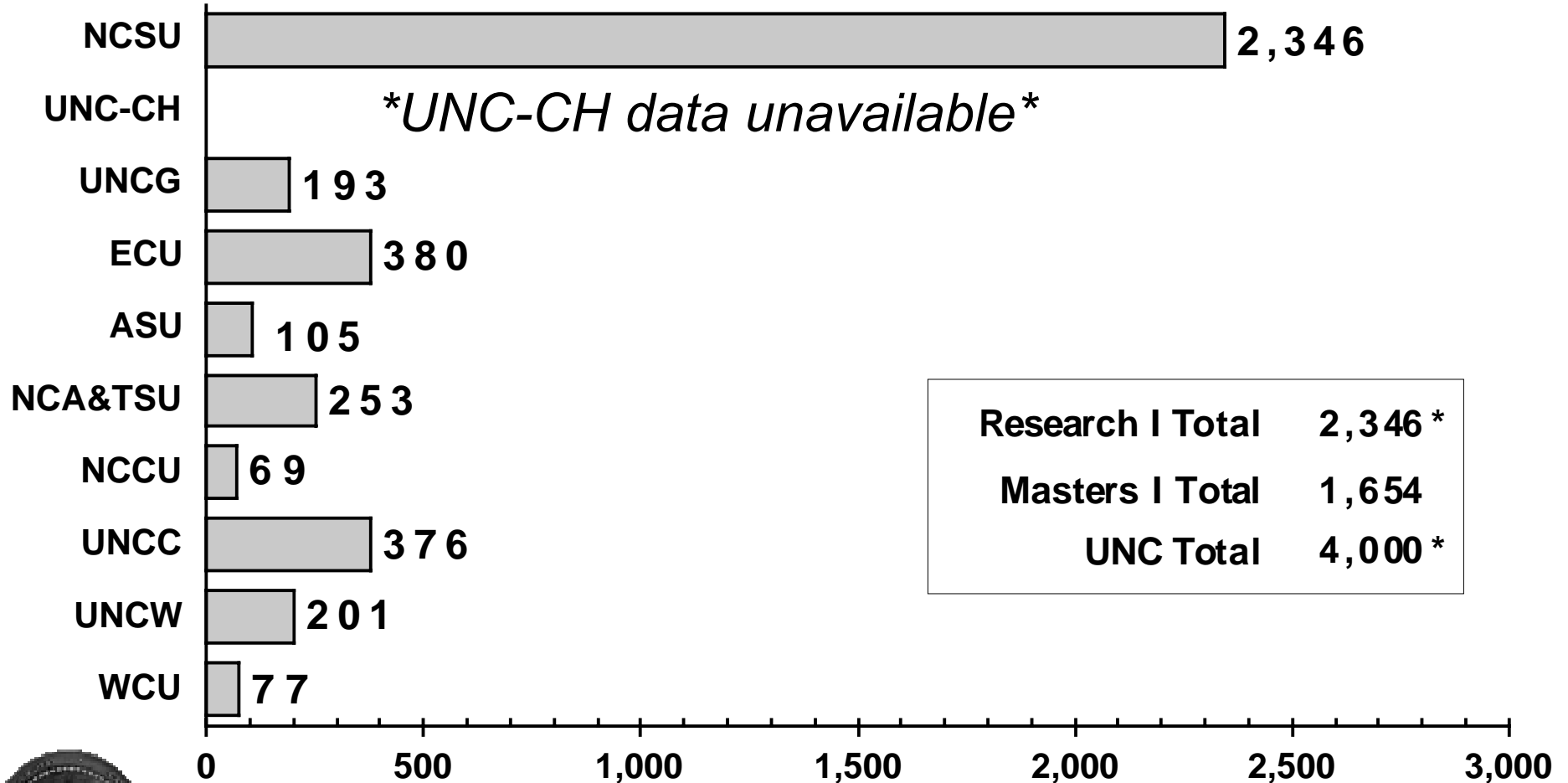

1999-2000 Dollar Value of Sponsored Research Proposals Submitted (and Percent Involving Collaboration)



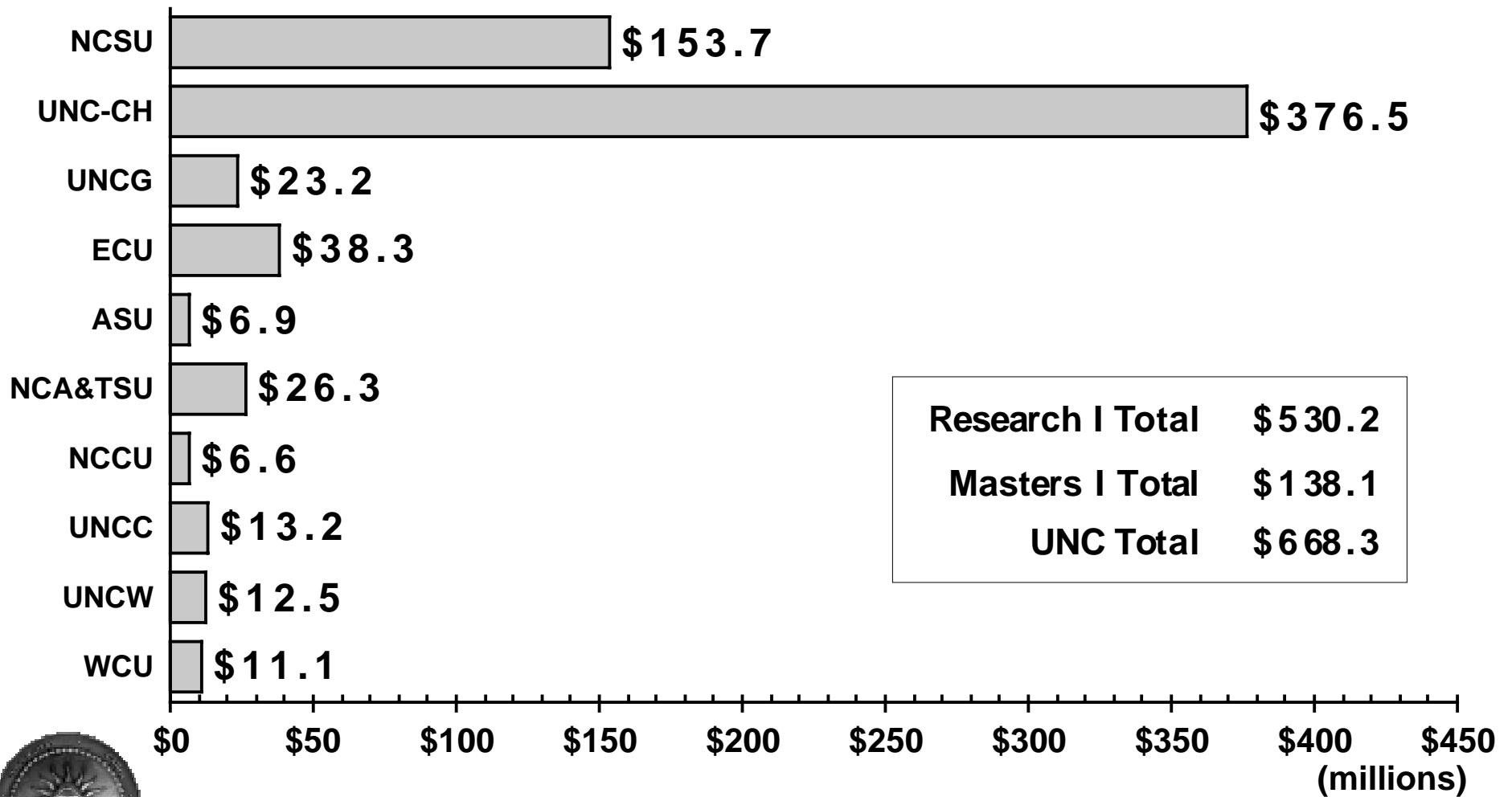

1999-2000 Number of Sponsored Research Awards



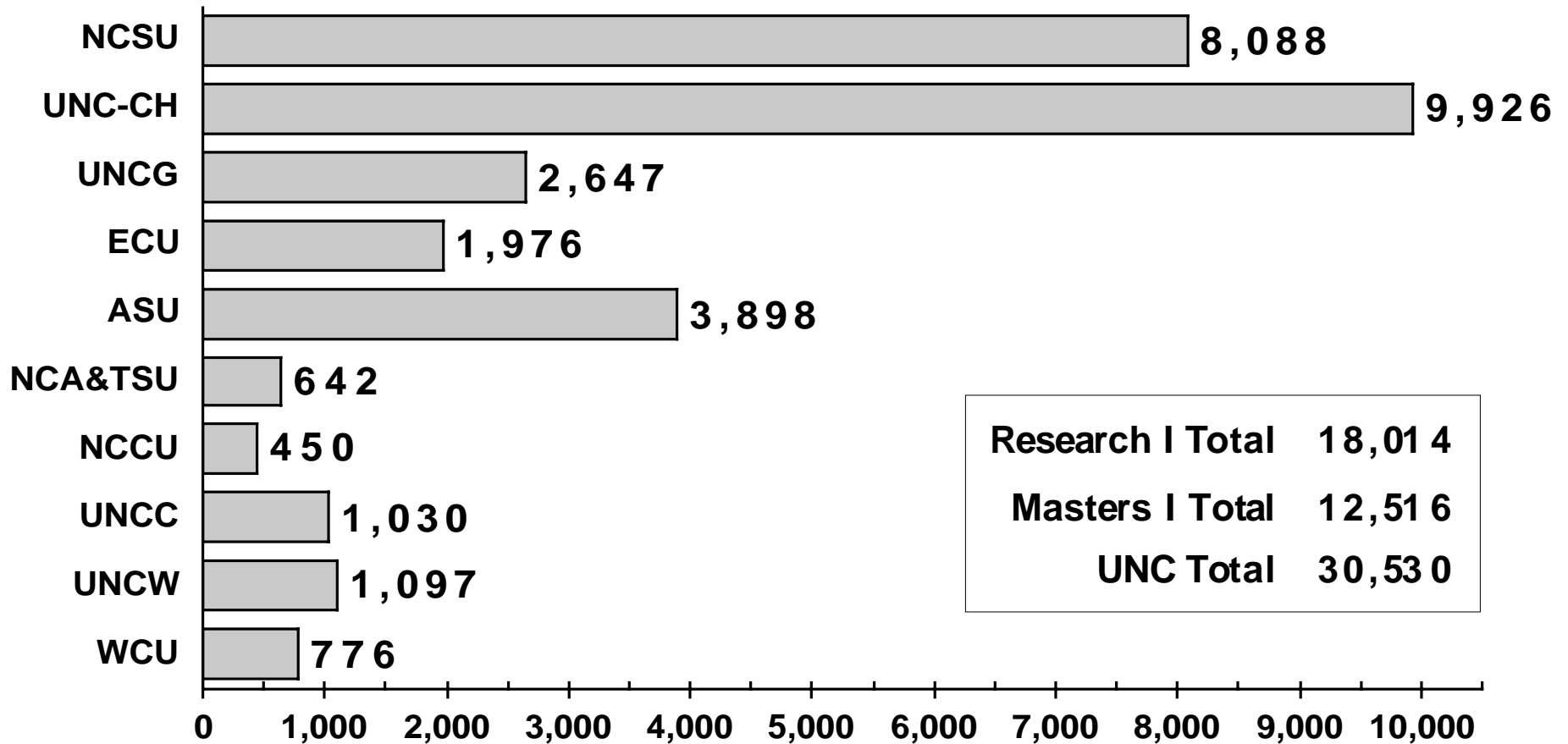

1999-2000 Dollar Value of Sponsored Research Awards



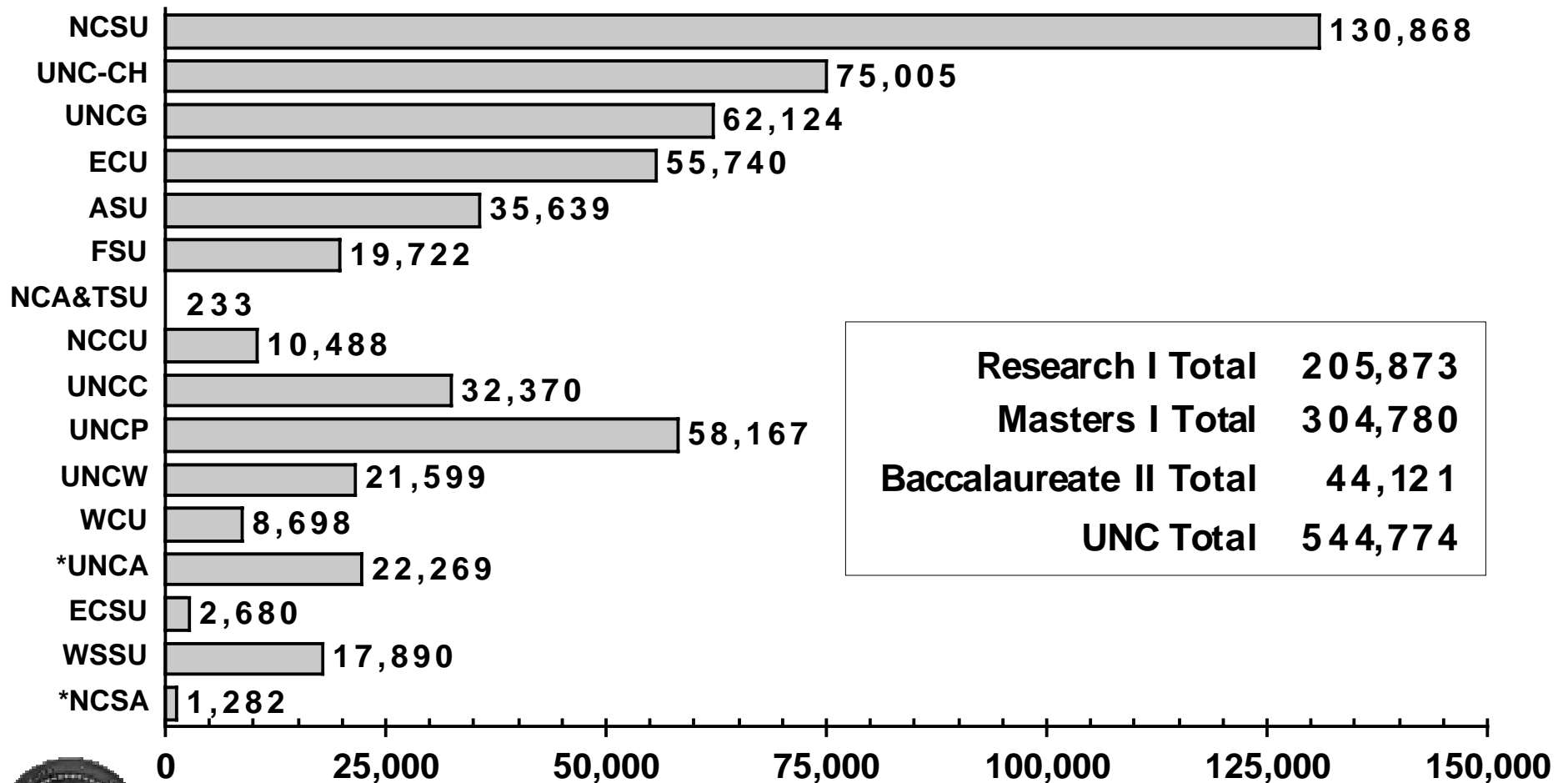

Annual Number of Books, Articles, Public Exhibits, and Performances Produced by Faculty, 1999-2000



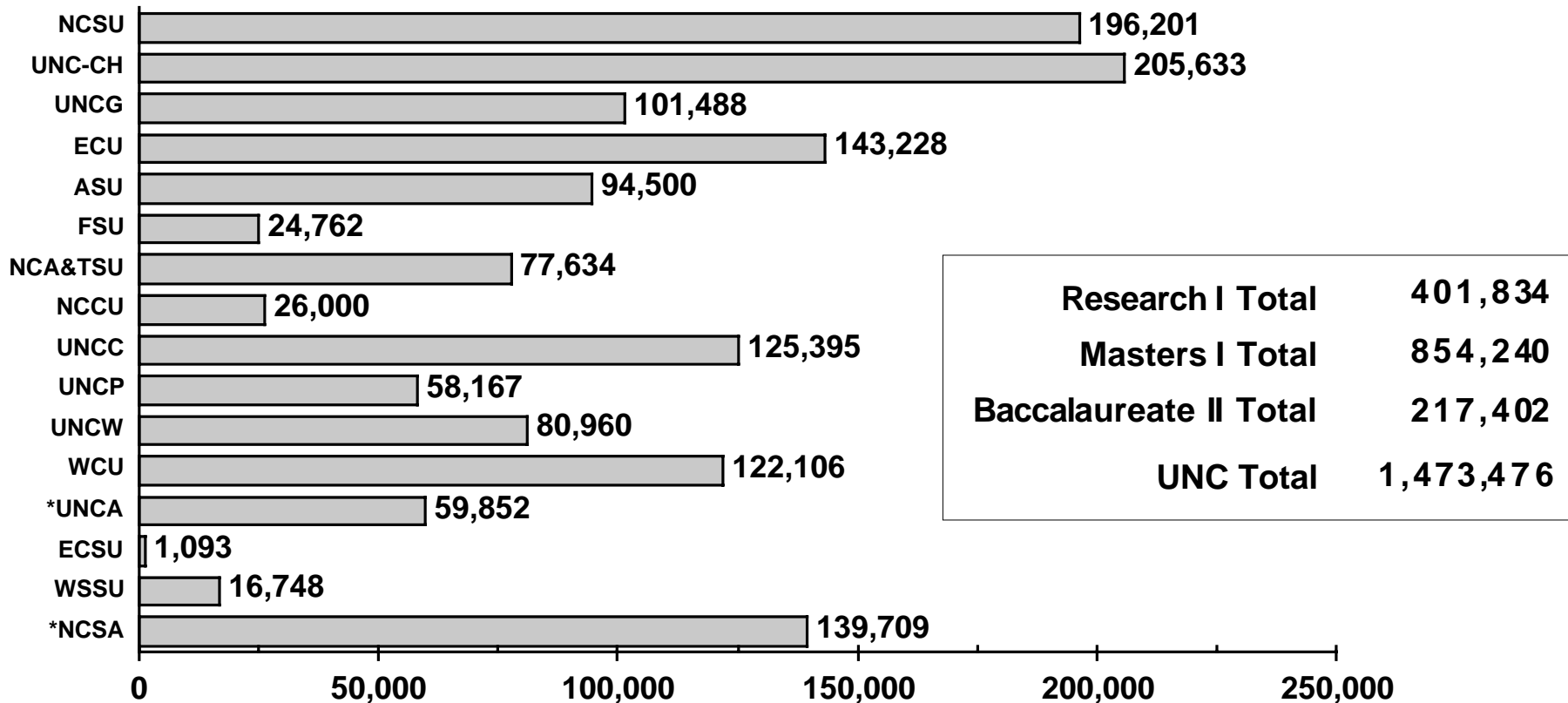

Registrants in Non-Degree-Credit Activities, 1999-2000



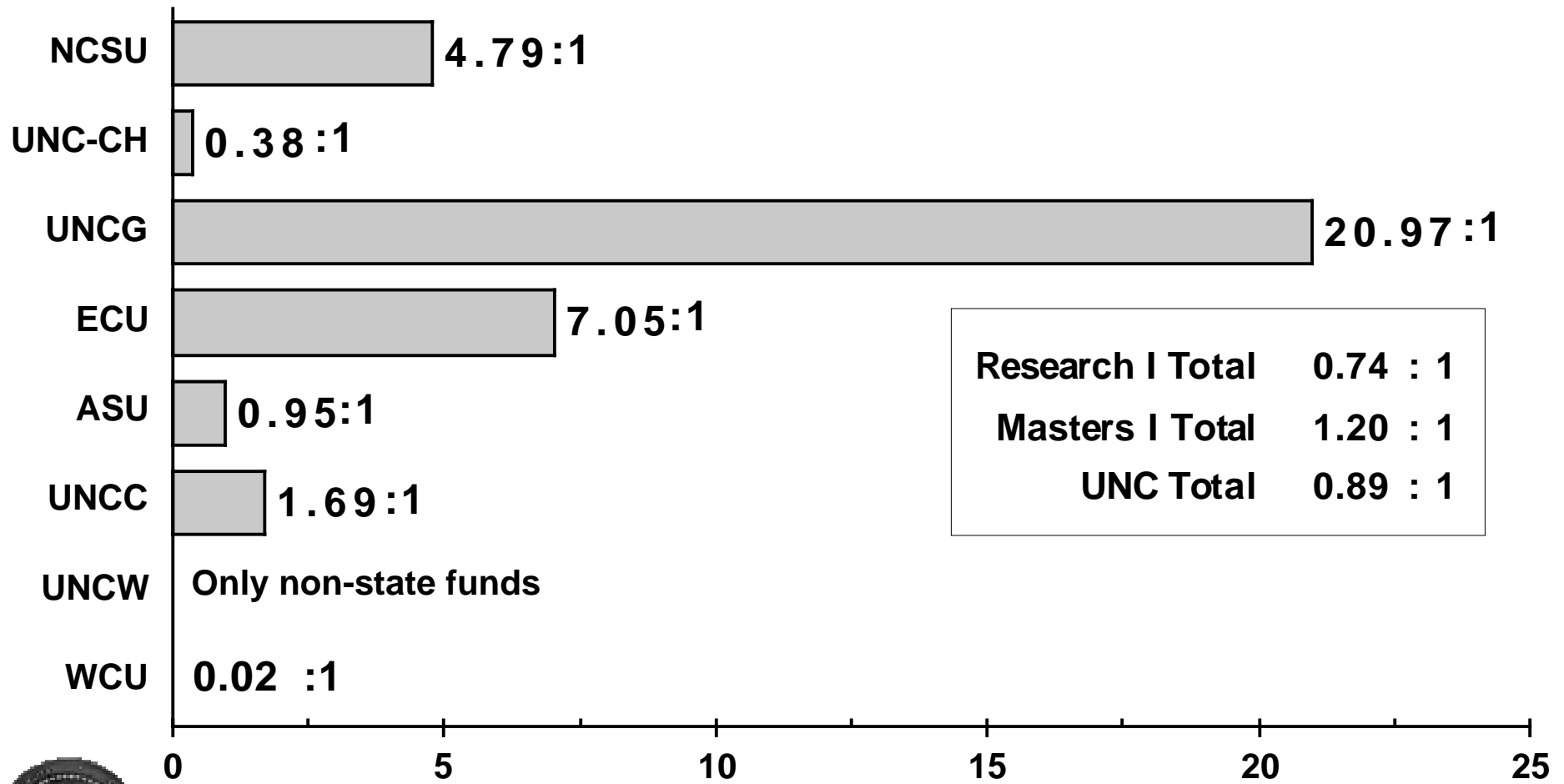

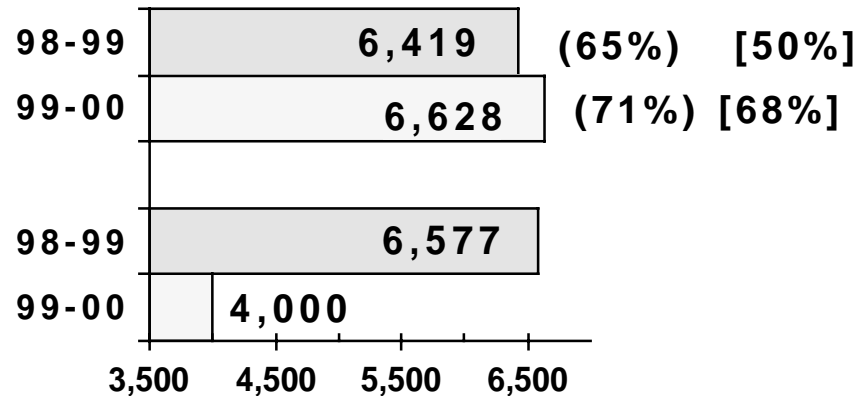
Ratio of Non-State to State Funds Generated by Public Service Institutes, 1999-2000



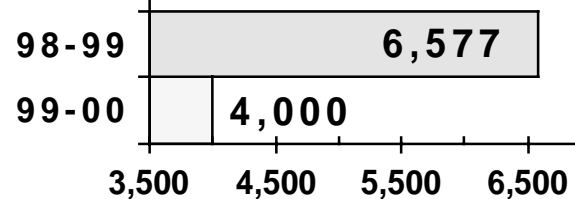

Comparison of Research P/PB Measures: 1998-99 with 1999-2000

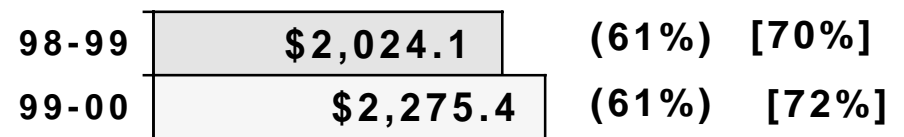
**No. Sponsored Research Proposals

[& Percent Involving Collaboration]**



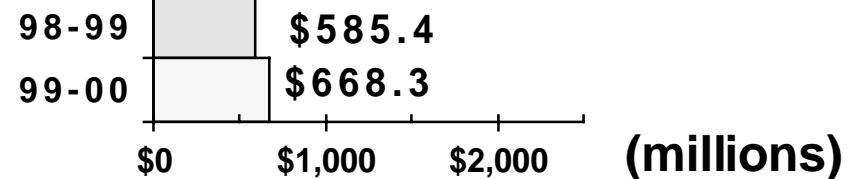
**No. Sponsored Research Awards
(Excludes UNC-CH data for 1999-00)**



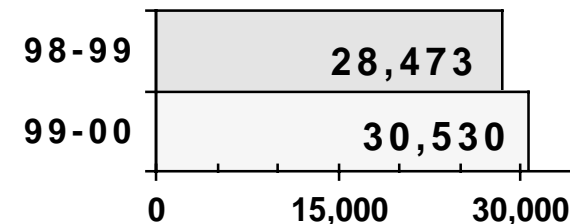
**\$ Value Sponsored Research Proposals

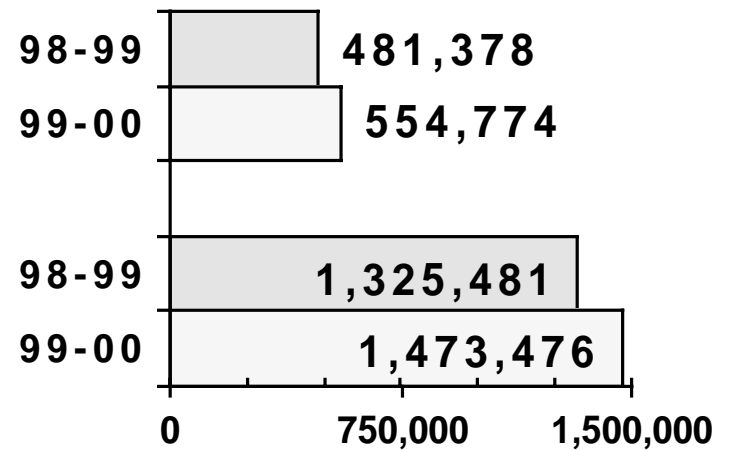
Annual No. Books, Articles, Public Exhibits, & Performances by Faculty



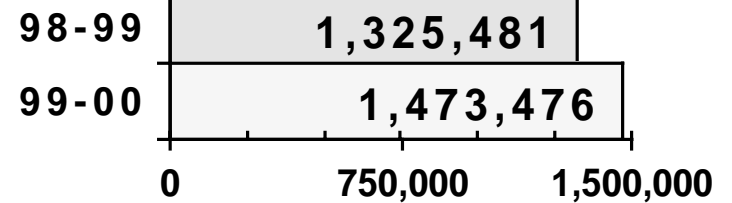
