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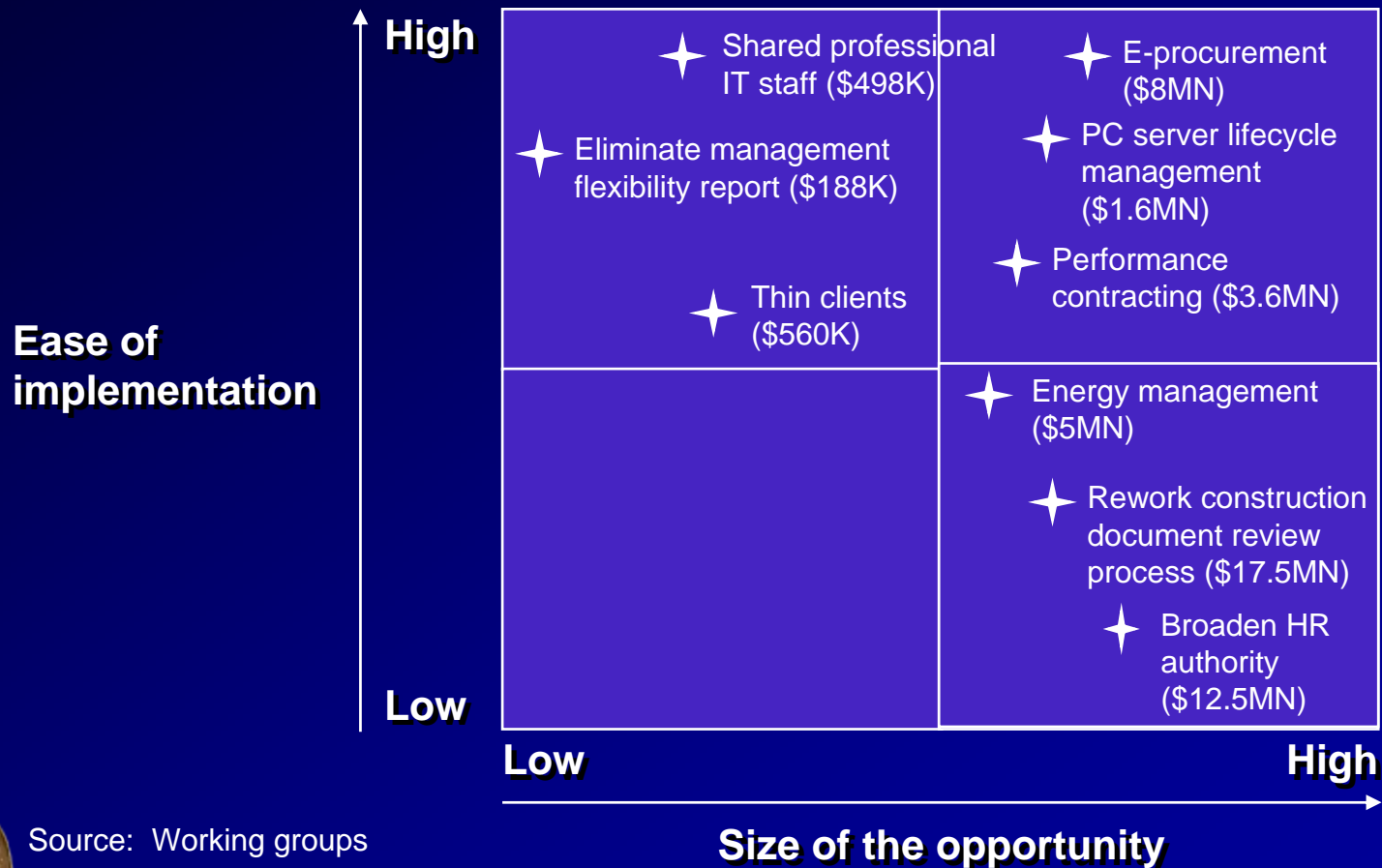

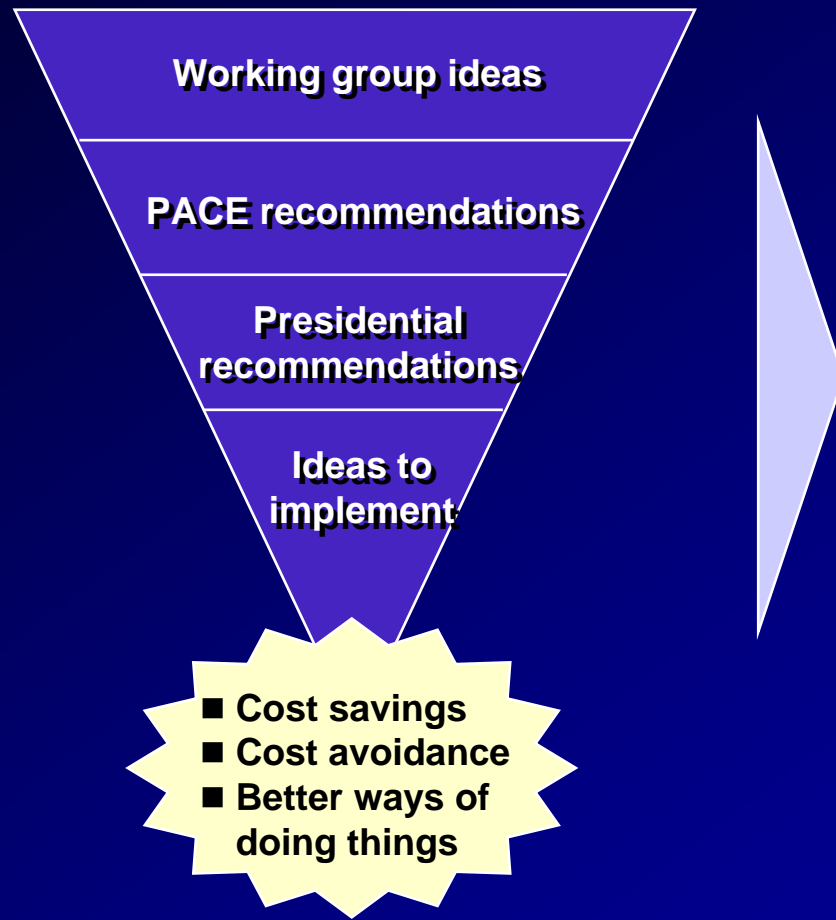

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## Key take-aways

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- Ideas require legislative, process or other change
- Some ideas require BOG approval
- Some ideas will be easier to implement than others
  - Legislative approval
  - Required investments



# *Making the most of two concurrent processes*

## Campus

Determine study areas

Final recommendations and supporting activities

Roll out implementation



## System

Refine recommendations

Modify processes, eliminate barriers

Roll out implementation

## Timeline

### Oct-Dec 2006

- PACE review to President; President review to BOG
- Form structure(s) for system-wide implementation
- Campuses assess own operations

### Jan-Mar 2007

- Campuses provide preliminary reports
- System-wide implementation begins
- Legislative discussions begin

### Apr-Jun 2007

- System-wide implementation continues
- Campuses issue final reports
- Amendments/changes to legislation
